Once again, God answered our prayers as a local ministry partner, Haven's Horses, who does therapeutic riding for people with disabilities, offered to host the outreach on their 55 acre ranch facility. What a great fit and fun change of venues! Even though we were unable to do

boat rides and kayaking, there was a stocked pond and outdoor pavilion on site allowing us to do all the other activities we normally have at the Expo. As a bonus, we were able to give more horse rides, paint some very patient ponies and even have three hayrides running all at the same time.



The weather that day, while hot as usual for Texas in June, was glorious and without a sprinkle! God brought together 875 participants, volunteers and exhibitors and the smiles, new friendships and presence of our Lord and Savior Jesus were all seen in so many places and in so many ways. In fact, it was as if God were showering blessings on us throughout the whole day. From the cheers at the welcome line with encouraging sidewalk chalk art to the smoked BBQ sliders served with other lunch items, the North Texas Expo, despite being moved to a new location just ten days before, was full of God's blessings.

All in all, it reminds us of both the power of prayer and God's faithfulness. He always goes before us preparing the way and when we follow Him, we find that as the 23rd Psalm says: "Surely goodness and mercy will follow me all the days of my life".
